Dear Mr. Tallman:

The Kainai Community Corrections Society, Correctional Centre Subsidiary Agreement and Native Elder Subsidiary Agreement expire on March 31, 2010. This letter provides formal notice that these Subsidiary Agreements will not be re-negotiated for the 2010/2011 fiscal year and will therefore expire on March 31, 2010 as outline in section 2.1 of the Subsidiary Agreements.

The Kainai Community Corrections Society, Community Supervision Subsidiary Agreement will also expire on March 31, 2010 and it is our intention to enter into negotiations for a Service Agreement for community supervision services for the 2010/2011 fiscal year. A representative from Correctional Services will be in contact with you in the near future to commence discussions related to these services.

This letter also serves as notice of termination of the Kainai Community Corrections Society Master Agreement. As per section 35(a), this Agreement is terminated without cause effective August 31, 2010. Please be advised that as per section 14 of the Master Agreement, the Society shall provide the Minister audited financial statements for the previous fiscal year by June 30, 2010.


The decision not to renew the Kainai Community Corrections Society, Correctional Centre and Native Elder Subsidiary Agreements reflect the low utilization rate at the centre over an extended period of time, which makes the centre's operation not economically viable.

Notice is also given that the Crime Prevention Coordinator position funded under the agreement between this Department and the Kainai Community Corrections Society, which expires on March 31, 2010, will not be renewed.
