The Candidate:

The Chief of Police, under the direction of the Police Commission, will be responsible for managing, planning, organizing and coordinating the work of 31 sworn officers, 18 civilian personnel in day to day operations as well as the Victim Services Unit. The Chief of Police will work closely with various community stakeholders in strategic governance as well as establish ,implement and manage operational policies and procedures in keeping with legal requirements, ethics and professional standards consistent with the overall mission, values and goals of the Blood Tribe Police Service. The successful candidate will have the following key qualifications:

- Extensive Law Enforcement experience performing several different policing tasks over a minimum of a 15 year period (15 to 20 years);
- Documented supervisory experience at the senior management level;
- Graduated from an approved policing training program;
- Shall possess strength of character, a high degree of personal integrity and have demonstrated a commitment to community service;
- Ongoing development and upgrading from a police, community college and/or university's;
- The ability to develop a departmental budget, control expenditures of departmental appropriations and otherwise manage resources in a law enforcement agency;
- Thorough knowledge of and sensitivity to the diversity of the Blood Tribe people, organizations, communities, culture and traditions, as well as experience working with the Federal, Provincial and First Nations governments;
- Strong public relations, interpersonal and negotiation skills with proven ability to establish, build and maintain excellent partner and stakeholder relationships in order to influence effective outcomes;
- Superior verbal and written communication skills;
- Knowledge of the Blackfoot culture is an asset;
- Demonstrate strong leadership skills;
- Sufficient police experience to effectively meet the modern and traditional demands of policing;
- Strong public relations, interpersonal and negotiation skills with proven ability to establish, build and maintain excellent partner and stakeholder relationships in order to influence effective outcomes.
